An individual may be nominated for selection as a Fellow Member or Honorary Fellow on the basis for his/her distinguished sustained professional contributions to the advancement of the Technology, Management, Practice and Teaching of the Arts and Sciences of Navigation, and/or for lifetime contributions to the Institute. The intent is to select Fellows for Sustained contributions, rather than specific accomplishments, for which other awards are more appropriate.

Only active ION members may submit nominations. All nominations must be in conformance with ION nominations guidelines as outlined in this nomination form. **Only nominations received in correct form by October 15 will be considered.**

This summary should not exceed one page (500 words or less) in length, and should include:

- A. Sustained professional contributions to the advancement of the Arts and Science of Navigation in one or more of the following areas:
 - Technology
 - Management
 - Practice
 - Teaching
- B. Papers published at ION conferences.
- C. Awards received from ION or other navigation-related awards and recognitions.
- D. Number of years working in navigation.

In not more than 25 words, describe the specific documented contributions of the nominee.

Please include three one-page letters of reference from individual professional references who are familiar with the nominee's contributions and accomplishments.
